This event was designed to be the establishment of a vocational ministry through the Church. Instead of simply providing a helping hand through a benevolence fund, the church will provide a "hand up" by showing people love and meeting a felt need through meaningful employment. We look forward to partnering with more churches who are willing to reach their communities through vocational ministry.
